The key to a successful program is the staff, and the Club has a great one here at ESUMC.



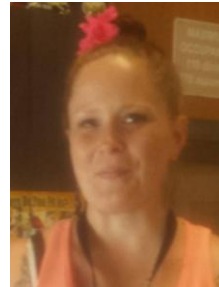

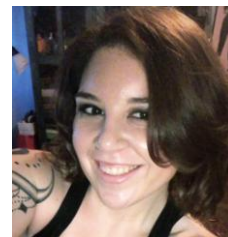
